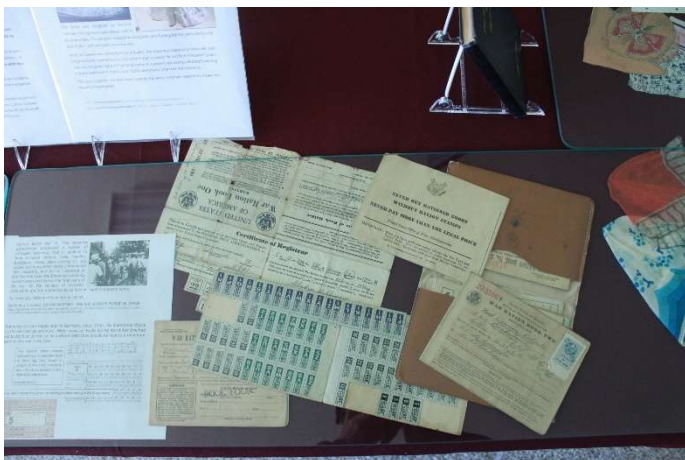


IN RELATED NEWS...
